
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 4.204-9/08*

IN RE: SURETY BONDS
AND CASH BONDS

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

1. All surety bond contracts submitted to the Sheriff or Clerk for the release of a prisoner shall specifically indicate that the prisoner is returnable to either the county court or the circuit court, provided, however, that the filed information arises from the original booking for which the bond was posted.
2. The Clerk and the Sheriff shall not accept a surety bond contract for the release of a prisoner unless the contract contains the above provisions.
3. In any instance where a cash bond is set, the Sheriff shall accept a surety bond in the same amount for the release of a prisoner.
