IN RE: PERSONS IN CUSTODY FOR
OUT-OF-COUNTY HOLDS

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of **General Practice &** Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED** as follows:

- 1. In order to prevent overcrowding at the Palm Beach County Jail, all persons being held in custody pursuant to a hold for an out-of-county misdemeanor, traffic or related contempt warrant shall be released within seventy-two (72) hours if not picked up by the authorities requesting the hold.
- 2. Persons held at the Palm Beach County Jail for a failure to appear or a violation of probation related to an out-of-county misdemeanor may be released after 10 (ten) business days from the date of booking and notification to the entity responsible for the out-of-county hold.
- 3. The Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office will, immediately upon booking an individual in **either of these** categories, notify the requesting authorities of the contents of this Administrative Order and that the requested person is in custody.
