



## PHASE REQUIREMENTS\*

Phase	Court Appearance	Requirements	Expected Duration
I	Every 2 Weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Submit to random drug testing, 2 times per week</li> <li>• Participate in Orientation meeting with Coordinator</li> <li>• Review of Dependency Case Plan tasks</li> <li>• Complete treatment assessment to determine treatment recommendation (if not already engaged)</li> <li>• Follow all treatment recommendations; attend and participate in required sessions</li> <li>• Attend and abide by court-ordered visitation with child(ren)</li> <li>• Weekly check in with Drug Court Coordinator</li> <li>• Check in with Dependency Case Manager every 14 days</li> <li>• Attend 2-3 AA/NA meetings OR equivalent sober support approved by Team per week <u>and</u> submit documentation</li> <li>• Identify support network and potential delegates for visitation</li> <li>• Attend all required Court hearings</li> <li>• Continue to work on Case Plan tasks</li> <li>• Completion of any corrective actions</li> </ul> <p>TO ADVANCE TO PHASE II: Complete 30 days <b>and</b> comply with requirements listed above</p>	30 days**
II	Every 2 Weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Submit to random drug testing, 2 per week</li> <li>• Attend and participate in all treatment services; progress towards treatment goals</li> <li>• Attend and abide by court-ordered visitation with child(ren)</li> <li>• Weekly check in with Drug Court Coordinator</li> <li>• Check in with Dependency Case Manager every 14 days</li> <li>• Attend 2-3 AA/NA meetings OR equivalent sober support approved by Team per week <u>and</u> submit documentation</li> <li>• Obtain a Sponsor and/or Peer Recovery Support Specialist</li> <li>• Attend all required Court hearings</li> <li>• Engage support network with Family Drug Court program and hearings (friend/family &amp; children)</li> <li>• Continue to work on Case Plan tasks</li> <li>• Completion of any corrective actions</li> </ul> <p>TO ADVANCE TO PHASE III: Negative screens for last 30 days (min) <b>and</b> comply with requirements listed above</p>	60 days**

\* The Court may modify these requirements based on an individual's needs and progress.

\*\*Expected length of time in each phase is based on participant engagement and individual progress

III	Every 2 Weeks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Submit to random drug testing, 2 per week</li> <li>● Attend and participate in all treatment services; progress towards treatment goals</li> <li>● Attend and abide by court-ordered visitation with child(ren)</li> <li>● Weekly check in with Drug Court Coordinator</li> <li>● Check in with Dependency Case Manager every 14 days</li> <li>● Attend 2-3 AA/NA meetings OR equivalent sober support approved by Team per week <u>and</u> submit documentation</li> <li>● Obtain stable <i>employment</i></li> <li>● Obtain stable <i>housing</i></li> <li>● Attend all required Court hearings</li> <li>● Continue to engage support network with Family Drug Court program and hearings (friend/family &amp; children)</li> <li>● Continue to work on Case Plan tasks</li> <li>● Completion of any corrective actions</li> </ul>	60 days**
CONTINUING CARE		<p>TO ADVANCE TO PHASE IV: Negative screens for last 45 days (min) <b>and</b> comply with requirements listed above</p>	
IV	Monthly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Submit to random drug testing, 2 per week</li> <li>● Attend and participate in all treatment services; progress towards treatment goals</li> <li>● Weekly check in with Drug Court Coordinator</li> <li>● Check in with Dependency Case Manager every 14 days</li> <li>● Attend 4 AA/NA meetings OR equivalent sober support approved by Team per week <u>and</u> submit documentation</li> <li>● Reunification with child(ren) if not already reunified</li> <li>● Maintain stable <i>employment</i></li> <li>● Maintain stable <i>housing</i></li> <li>● Attend all required Court hearings</li> <li>● Continue to engage support network with Family Drug Court program and hearings (friend/family &amp; children)</li> <li>● Continue to work on Case Plan tasks</li> <li>● Completion of any corrective actions</li> </ul>	90 days**
STABILITY		<p>TO ADVANCE TO PHASE V: 60 days of <i>consecutive</i>, negative screens and comply with requirements listed above</p>	
V	Monthly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Submit to random drug testing, 2 per week <b>OR</b> 1 per week at the discretion of the court</li> <li>● Attend and participate in all treatment services; progress towards treatment goals</li> <li>● Weekly check in with Drug Court Coordinator</li> <li>● Check in with Dependency Case Manager every 14 days</li> <li>● Attend 4 AA/NA meetings OR equivalent sober support approved by Team per week <u>and</u> submit documentation</li> <li>● Maintain stable <i>employment</i></li> <li>● Maintain and strengthen reunification</li> <li>● Maintain stable <i>housing</i></li> <li>● Comply with Case Plan tasks</li> <li>● Attend all required Court hearings</li> <li>● Develop and present <i>aftercare</i> plan to continue engagement with support network to aid continued sobriety</li> <li>● Completion of any corrective actions</li> </ul>	90 days**
INDEPENDENCE		<p>TO GRADUATE: 90 days of <i>consecutive</i>, negative screens and comply with requirements listed above</p>	

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
