

How to Get Your Florida Driver's License

Ages 16-17

- Must have Learner's License for 1 year (12 months).
- Must pass the Class E Knowledge Exam/Permit Test,
 - Exam can be taken in school through driver's education class, or online by any authorized provider (see list below)
- Must pass Driver Education Traffic Safety (DETS) Course,
 - Course can be taken online by any authorized provider (see list below)
- Must have a signed Parental consent form
 - Visit www.flhsmv.gov/pdf/forms/71142.pdf for Parental Consent Form



Ages 18 and older

Must complete the following

- Traffic Law and Substance Abuse Education (TLSAE) Course,
 - Course can be taken online by an authorized provider (see list below)
- Vision and hearing test, can be taken at DMV when receiving license
- The Class E Knowledge Exam, can only be taken in person at DMV for \$55
 - This fee can be paid via credit card, cash, money order and check in person at the DMV
- Driving skills exam or road test, can be taken in person at DMV
- Must schedule DMV appointment online before taking any Exam or Test (see list of required documents)

Before scheduling an appointment online you will need to have the following documents:

One of the following documents for proof of identity

- U.S. birth certificate, valid U.S. passport, valid alien registration receipt card, green card, form I-551, certificate of citizenship

One of the following documents for Social Security documents

- social security card, W-2 form, or paycheck/stub, 1099 form, SSA-1099

Two of the following documents for proof of Residential Address

- Household information document- Deed, monthly mortgage statement, residential rental/lease agreement, A letter from a homeless shelter, transitional service provider, or half-way house verifying that the customer resides at the shelter address (must be dated within the last 60 days), Florida Voter Registration Card, Valid Florida Vehicle/Vessel Registration or Title, or utilities bills from the last 60 days, Parental Consent form (ages 16-17)
