GENERAL VOIR DIRE QUESTIONS:

- 1. Full Name.
- 2. Town or city you live in (not your actual street address).
- 3. Occupation (former occupation if you are retired or unemployed)
- 4. Marital status (single, married, divorced, widowed)
- Spouse's occupation (former occupation if retired, divorced or deceased)
- 6. Number of children or grandchildren (if applicable)
- 7. Adult children or grandchildren's occupations (if applicable)
- 8. Prior jury service (this week or any other time or place)
- 9. Are you a party in any pending or past lawsuits? (civil or criminal)
- Do you know anyone in the courtroom? (Judge, other jurors, lawyers, bailiff, court reporter, clerk, etc.)
- 11. Can and will you be a fair juror in this case?

Juror Responsibilities Regarding the Internet and Social Media

FAIRNESS TO THE PARTIES IN ALL CASES REQUIRES THAT JURORS FOLLOW THESE RULES:

- Don't research the case online in any way, including searching for information about the attorneys or judge.
- Don't communicate anything about the case via Facebook,
 Twitter, Instagram or any online messaging service.
- · Follow instructions by the judge or other court personnel.
- Immediately report unauthorized use of the Internet or social media to the judge or authorized court personnel.

By following these simple rules, jurors help ensure that all parties receive a fair trial.
