# INSTRUCTIONS FOR PETITION TO SUPERSEDE AND OR MODIFY ADMINISTRATIVE CHILD SUPPORT ORDER

#### When should this form be used?

This form should be used by either parent or a non parent who has custody of a minor child to ask the court to supersede and or modify an <u>administrative child support order</u> that has previously been established in an administrative hearing pursuant to section 409.2563 Florida Statutes.

This form should be typed or printed in black ink. After completing this form, you should sign the form before a **notary public** or **deputy clerk**. You should **file** this document with the **clerk of the circuit court** and keep a copy for your records.

With this petition, you must file the following and provide a copy to the other party:

- **Notice of Related Case Form**, Florida Supreme Court Approved Family Law Form 12.900(h).
- **Notice of Social Security Number**, Florida Supreme Court Approved Family Law Form 12.902(j). Entire social security number must be provided.
- **Family Law Financial Affidavit**, Florida Family Law Rules of Procedure Form 12.902(b) or (c).
- Certificate of Compliance with Mandatory Disclosure, Florida Family Law Rules of Procedure Form 12.932. (This must be filed within 45 days, if not filed with the petition, unless you and the other party have agreed not to exchange these documents.)
- Child Support Guidelines Worksheet, Florida Family Law Rules of Procedure Form12.902(e). (If you do not know the other party's income, you may file this worksheet after his or her financial affidavit has been filed.)
- Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act (UCCJEA) Affidavit, Florida Supreme Court Approved Family Law Form 12.902(d)

#### What should I do next?

For your case to proceed, you must **serve** the other party with a copy of your **petition** by **personal service**.

You must also <u>serve</u> Florida Department of Revenue (DOR) with a copy of your <u>petition</u> at the address that is provided on the administrative order establishing child support.

After the petition is served, the other party has 20 days to answer. Your case will then generally proceed in one of the following three ways:

### **DEFAULT**

If after 20 days, no <u>answer</u> has been filed, you may file a <u>Motion for Default</u>, Florida Supreme Court Approved Family Law Form 12.922(a), with the clerk of court. After <u>Default</u> is entered, if you have filed all of the required papers, you MUST file a <u>Notice for Trial</u>, Florida Supreme Court Approved Family Law Form 12.924, with the clerk of court. You will receive an Order Setting Hearing.

# **UNCONTESTED**

If the other party files an answer that agrees with everything in your petition or an answer and waiver, **and** you have complied with <u>mandatory disclosure</u> and filed all of the required papers, you MUST file a <u>Notice</u> <u>for Trial</u>, Florida Supreme Court Approved Family Law Form 12.924, with the clerk of court . You will receive an Order Setting Hearing.

## **CONTESTED**

If the other party files an answer or an answer and <u>counterpetition</u>, which disagrees with or denies anything in your petition, **and** you are unable to settle the disputed issues, you may be referred to **mediation** to resolve the disputed issues. If the respondent files an answer and counterpetition, you should answer the counterpetition within 20 days using an **Answer to Counterpetition**, Florida Supreme Court Approved Family Law Form 12.983(d). Following the mediation, you should file a **Notice for Trial**, Florida Supreme Court Approved Family Law Form 12.924, after you have complied with mandatory disclosure, and filed all of the required papers. You will receive an Order Setting Hearing.

#### Where can I look for more information?

Before proceeding, you should read "General Information for Pro Se Litigants" found at the beginning of the Florida Family Law forms. The words that are in "bold underline" in these instructions are defined there. For further information, see chapter 742, Florida Statutes.
